

Dr. Sian Beilock in the Department of Psychology at the **University of Chicago** is seeking to make one full-time Post-Doctoral appointment. This research-oriented position will focus on the cognitive and neural bases of skill learning and performance in healthy individuals, with special emphasis on understanding how high-stress situations compromise the learning and performance of complex cognitive tasks such as math problem solving and reasoning. The research will combine a variety of measures including fMRI, behavioral measures, and physiological measures of stress. Requirements include a Ph.D. in cognitive science, neuroscience or psychology with research interests in cognitive neuroscience. Responsibilities include experiment design, training and supervising of research assistants, running of experiments in the fMRI scanner, data collection, analysis of fMRI and other data, grant and manuscript preparation. Salary is in accordance with NIH standards. Start date is August or September, 2008.
